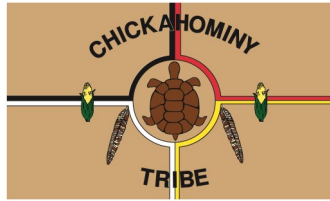

The Chickahominy Tribal Council has hired Nelson Andrews and the Horsley Witten Group, Inc. to assist with the development of the Chickahominy Tribe Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan. A draft plan is now ready for review and public comment on the Tribe's website. Join us to learn about the process to date and the mitigation actions included in the plan.

Why is this important? Hazard mitigation planning enables Tribal governments to identify risks and vulnerabilities associated with natural, human-caused and technological disasters, and develop long-term strategies for protecting people and property from future hazard events. A hazard mitigation plan should be considered a living document that must grow and adapt, keeping pace with a community's growth and change. The Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA) places high priority on the continuation of the planning process after the initial submittal, requiring communities to seek and receive re-approval from FEMA in order to remain eligible for financial assistance.
